AlexLoop Magnetic Loop Antenna Presentation

If you weren't at the November 17 ACARA meeting you missed excellent presentation by Tom Rockhold, NØOGS, on his AlexLoop Magnetic Loop Antenna.

The AlexLoop (http://www.alexloop.com/) is a lightweight, truly portable 10m-40m HF antenna. Tom uses his AlexLoop at his antenna-restricted residence as well as when operating afield with his Elecraft KX3. Tom explained that the bandwidth of the antenna is very narrow—as would be expected of a physically very small antenna—but tuning is very quick and easy. The design effectively limits interference (QRM) from adjacent frequencies as well as providing meaningful directivity.

Field Day 2016

It's not too early to start planning for Field Day 2016 which happens the weekend of June 25-26, 2016. For the first time, the ACARA has been given permission to use both the Kiwanis Shelter and the large brick building at the Athens County Fairgrounds this year. Eric McFadden has already scouted out the brick building and has some ideas for antenna deployment and station set-up, which leads to...

... Eric has a Mosley TA-33 tri-band (10/15/20m) yagi antenna available for the club to use atop the 9-1-1 Center's 50' crank-up mobile tower. This yagi was retired by Eric's father, W8EOG, several years ago and needs cleaning and possibly some restoration work before it can be successfully redeployed. Fortunately, Mosley beams are easy and inexpensive to work on. An article in the July, 2015, QST (pages 39-40) provides complete guidance on the process. Is someone in the club willing to take on the task of cleaning and restoring this antenna for the club's use as a Field Day antenna? (Eric promises he won't install the TA-33 above his roof if the club restores it!)

For 2016, Andy Young, KD8WVX, will serve as HF SSB (voice) station captain and has equipment and ideas that should measurably improve the club's success using SSB. Eric will serve again as HF CW station captain. John McCutcheon, N8XWO, will again serve as VHF SSB/CW station captain.

In 2016, for the first time, the ACARA will have a computer network to allow the three stations (HF CW, HF SSB, VHF SSB/CW) to simultaneously log to the same computer file. Jeff Slattery, N8SUZ, will be working the magic to make this happen.
